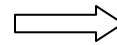

***SPRING MISSIONS SUNDAY – APRIL 29, 2018**

Ricky & Chenea Pfisterer will be our Spring Missions Sunday guest speakers. They work for DiscipleMakers, which is a Pennsylvania based college ministry and they currently serve at Penn State and Penn State Altoona's campus. Their motto is "Reaching the Campus...Reaching the World". Their vision is that as we meet, befriend, reach and disciple college students we have the opportunity to mobilize them for the Great Commission. At college campuses they have future leaders in all fields who will go all over the world after college. They also have students from all over the world coming to American schools. So the opportunity is much greater than reaching one campus but the opportunity to reach the world for Christ. They focus on teaching our students what it means to be a follower of Christ at college, how to know, study and teach God's Word as well as help them to become disciplemakers in their spheres of influence.

They were deeply impacted by the Gospel as college students. Ricky was impacted directly by DiscipleMakers at Bloomsburg University. Chenea became a Christian in college at Arizona State and was welcomed into a local church and discipled by an older woman.
